**A BILL**

To require certain meetings of the Tennessee Valley Authority to be transparent and open to the public, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Tennessee Valley Au-  
5       thority Transparency Act of 2019”.

6       **SEC. 2. TRANSPARENCY AND AVAILABILITY OF MEETINGS.**

7       Section 2(g)(2) of the Tennessee Valley Authority  
8       Act of 1933 is amended to read as follows:

1           “(2) MEETINGS.—

2                   “(A) IN GENERAL.—The Board shall meet  
3           at least 4 times each year.

4                   “(B) TRANSPARENCY.—The Board shall,  
5           with respect to any meeting of the Board or a  
6           subcommittee of the Board for which a vote is  
7           not scheduled—

8                           “(i) hold such meeting in public;

9                           “(ii) provide public notice of no fewer  
10           than 6 calendar days, through the website  
11           of the Board, of any such meeting; and

12                           “(iii) make publicly available the min-  
13           utes and summaries of any such meeting.

14                   “(C) EMERGENCY MEETINGS.—Subpara-  
15           graph (B)(ii) shall not apply if the chairman of  
16           the Board designates a meeting as an emer-  
17           gency special meeting.”.
